with such detail. They truly “Made It Happen!” Incredible work!!

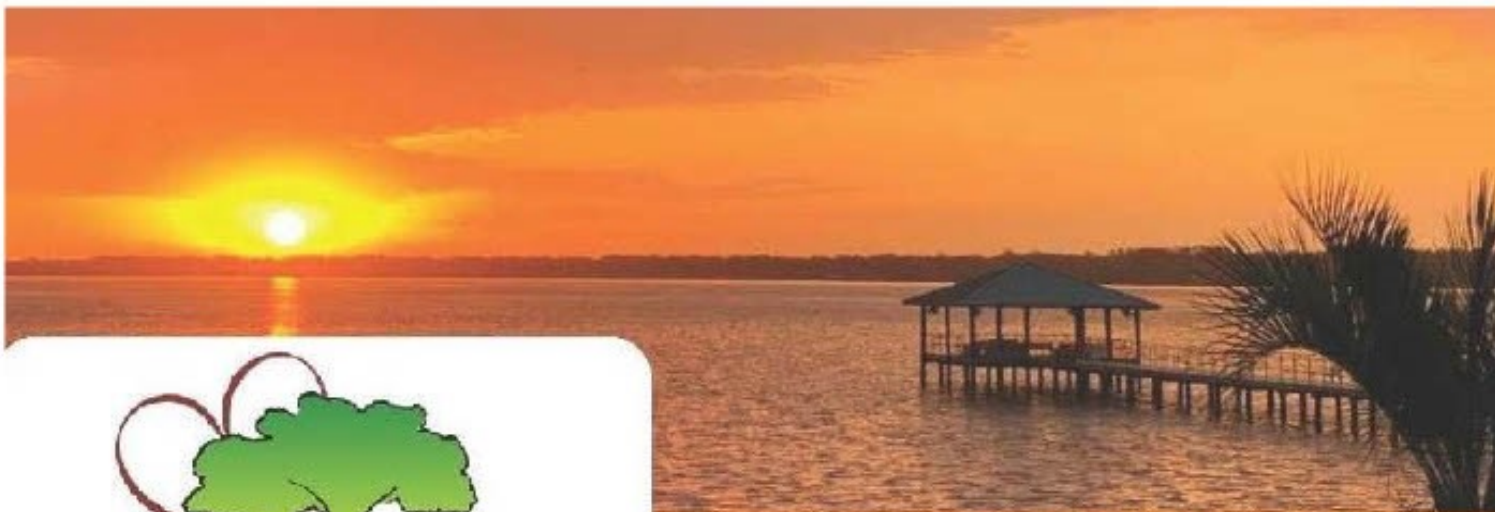
