TIME FRAME TO MEET!

- A. Lodge Level—Recommended recipient data must be Submitted to District President no later than April 30th of each year.
- B. District Level—Recommended recipient data must be Submitted to the Association Chairman no later than July 15th of each year.
- C. State Level-- State Recipient will be named and award Presented at the Annual Association Convention.
